



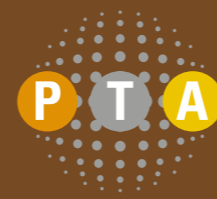
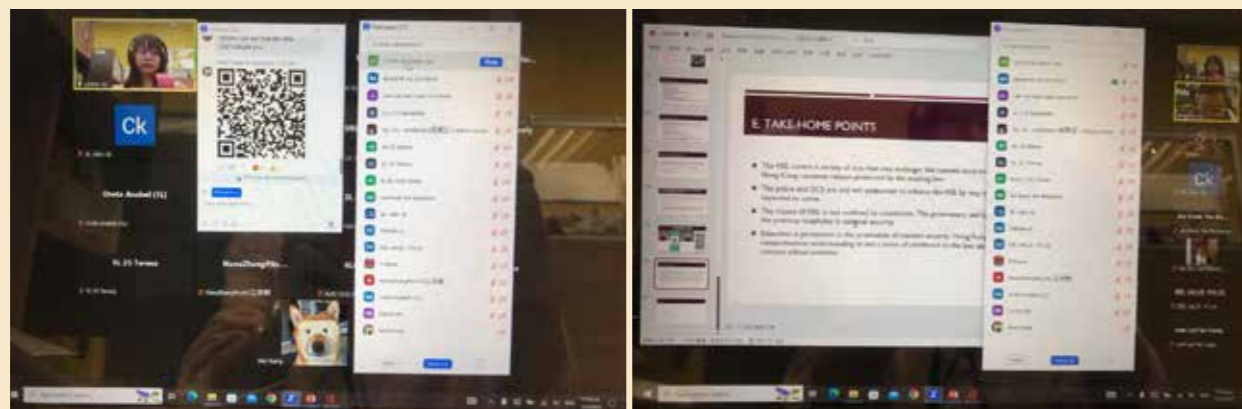
Parent Workshop: Herbarium and Meditation Workshop
