## Message from the Principal

Our school has two main objectives in this school year. Firstly, we will strengthen the Elite Programme and secondly we want to improve students' speaking proficiency.

In order to nurture the top students in Chinese, English, Mathematics and Arts and Sports, we have put a large amount of resources into the Elite Programme this year. In the academic aspect, we have set up 13 elite groups in Chinese, English and Mathematics which will run every week. These elite groups will benefit 163 students, about 56% of the students in the school. In Arts and Sports, we have launched an Arts and Sports Talents Seed Project. This project provides tailor-made training for talented students in Arts and Sports, so that they can develop their potential and improve their performance in these areas.

We believe every student has their own talent, whether it be in an academic or non-academic aspect. Through consistent effort and support from the school and parents, every student can fulfill their potential.

Also, we recognize that proficient speaking and communication skills are essential to develop good social networking skills and for furthering academic and future career prospects. Therefore, this year we will focus on helping our students to develop into confident and organized speakers.
