1. Donation of more than 800 books

4. Providing subsidies to 11 economically disadvantaged students for their participation in the after-school Homework Tutorial
5. Providing subsidies for all students' transportation fee to 20 Integration Programme activities
6. Providing nine sessions of Discovery Dome activities to introduce learning of space science
7. Providing two sets of quality English Phonics teaching materials and teacher training
8. Arranging for P.5 and P.6 students to meet a famous author and learn from his/her experiences
9. Giving out about 340 cupcakes to all students and teachers at the Christmas Party
10. Collaborating with South Island School (SIS) to promote the two schools' partnership development:
 - 10.1 Books and Furniture donation
 - 10.2 Teacher training, such as Problem Solving Skills and Study Skills
 - 10.3 SIS teachers and students provide secondary school admission interview training to P.6 students
 - 10.4 SIS students provide weekly individual tutorials to our students with learning difficulties
 - 10.5 SIS-LS joint school Mathematics Activity Day
