No.22042 : 2023/24 “Neighbourhood First · Rice-Giving Scheme”

Dear Parents,

The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups (HKFYG) has been in close partnership with Au Bak Ling Charity Trust (ABLCT) since April 2010 to establish the ‘Rice-Giving Scheme’ to support Hong Kong low-income earners by providing them material support and care.

1. Details of the program

- Approved family and individual applicants are eligible to collect a 5 kg bag of rice each month or every two months (odd-numbered months) respectively.
- The eligibility of the collection of rice lasts for one year, from April 2023 to March 2024.
- If an application is approved and the applicant is physically capable, he or she must collect the rice according to the designated time, date and rice station location; otherwise, he or she will be regarded as withdrawing from the scheme.

2. Eligibility

- The applicant must be a Hong Kong resident.
- Applicants who are not recipients of the Comprehensive Social Security (CSSA) Scheme or other periodical financial support will receive priority handling of their application.
- The applicant cannot be the beneficiary of this scheme for more than one year. (unless all family members are aged 65 or above, or some of the family members receive Disability Allowance.)
- The family should be a low income family (Monthly income lower than 75% of Median Monthly Domestic Household Income by Household Size. Refer to the chart overleaf) or is now receiving 2022-2023 School Textbook Assistance (Full Grant / Half Grant).
